GUIDE FOR THE INITIATIVE GOOD(s)2SHARE

- GOOD(s)2SHARE is an initiative implemented at the dormitories of Kaunas University of Technology (hereinafter – University), whereby students moving out or living in dormitories can donate the items they do not use that are still usable at the GOOD(s)2SHARE points in the dormitories, and the incoming students can pick them up for further use.
- 2. The main aim of the initiative is to contribute to the promotion of sustainability, responsible consumption and environmental responsibility in the University's dormitory community by giving away unwanted but still usable items to future dormitory residents.
- 3. The initiative GOOD(s)2SHARE only accepts items that are suitable for their intended use; the items are slightly used, neat and clean, fall into one of the specified categories of accepted items, are neatly prepared and packaged (if necessary), and are in working condition.

CONDITIONS FOR DONATION AND STORAGE OF ITEMS

- 4. Residents wishing to donate items should leave them at the GOOD(s)2SHARE point in the lobby of the dormitory.
- 5. Only the items that are neat, slightly used and in working order, that fit into the following categories, are accepted: kitchenware and small household appliances, electronics, educational and leisure items, cleaning tools and other items.
- 6. Items must be neatly prepared for donation and, if necessary, properly packed, not hazardous to other residents or University property.
- 7. Before donating electronic devices, make sure that they are in working order and safe to use.
- 8. Large household appliances, batteries, textiles and footwear, food products and medicines are not accepted.
- 9. The dormitory manager/administrator ensures that items are properly stored in the dormitory and handed over to the newly arriving students.
- 10. During the initiative GOOD(s)2SHARE, items are given to dormitory residents free of charge. There is no reservation of items.
- 11. Items can be picked up during the working hours of the administration of the Student Accommodation Centre, by contacting the manager/administrator of the dormitory or at the GOOD(s)2SHARE pick-up points that are open during the accommodation of the first-year students.
- 12. It is recommended to clean or disinfect all collected items before use.
- 13. The manager/administrator of the dormitory ensures that the collected items are safely stored and made available to the residents who need them.
- 14. The maximum storage period for items is 9 months. If the items are not collected within nine (9) months or, they are not in demand in the assessment of the manager/administrator of the Student Accommodation Centre, they are removed.
- 15. The GOOD(s)2SHARE point in the lobby of the dormitory does not accept large appliances such as fridges, freezers, washing machines, microwaves, pressure cookers, etc. If dormitory residents have any other items not on this list that they want to donate or sell, they should take a picture of them and post it on the Facebook group.
